

# Warren County Fire Academy Outreach Programs

## Description

To expand the training provided to the fire and emergency service community, “Outreach Programs” are available. These programs do not replace the normal schedule of training offered at the Academy, but will focus on presenting relevant subjects at your department’s headquarters.

When feasible, agencies requesting outreach programs may choose to invite other mutual aid agencies to the program. Topics can be tailored specifically to your department’s needs, and vary in nature from a general introductory type of presentation to one that is very specific in nature. Regulatory compliance courses are also available to enhance your department’s safety process. Again the emphasis being to reach a broader base of the fire service community. Typical offerings might include:

- FEMA NIMS I-400
- Traffic Incident Management
- Ladder Operations
- Firefighter Assistance Search Teams
- NFA Incident Safety Officer
- Regulatory Compliant Training
- Haz-Mat Awareness and Operations and Refreshers
- Foam Operations
- Pump Operations
- Fire Police

## Location

Activities will be conducted at your location providing that the facilities and equipment meet the acceptable standard for classroom presentations. Student seating, audio visual equipment, blackboards / whiteboards and air quality are some site requirements that must be satisfied.

## Staff

Will be provided by the Academy and based on the number of attendees and topic of instruction.

## Scheduling

Scheduling is arranged by the individual department's Fire Chief or Training Officer and is subject to the availability of Academy staff and course materials. Requests must be submitted 30 days prior to the beginning of class sessions. Upon the selection of instructors, the Academy will contact the requesting agency via telephone or email.
